What is Title I?

- ❑ Federally Allocated Funds to aid Schools
 - ❑ Title Funds: IA, IIA, and IVA

Title IA

- ❑ For programs to assist students based on educational need
- ❑ Must be based on multiple measures, such as national test results, classroom performance, and teacher recommendation

Title IIA

- ❑ For teacher programs such as professional development and mentoring

- ❑ Other uses such as STEAM are allowed

Title IVA

- ❑ Well-rounded education - STEAM, civics, arts, music, career counseling
- ❑ Safe and Healthy Students
- ❑ Effective Use of Technology

Past Uses of Title Funds

- ❑ After School Academic Support
- ❑ Summer program, including transportation
- ❑ Partial salaries of teachers providing academic support

- ❑ STEAM Program
- ❑ Technology Resources
- ❑ New teacher mentoring


