Dear Tri-Valley Community,

The health and safety of our students and staff remain our highest priorities. In accordance with New York State regulations, the Tri-Valley Central School District recently conducted routine testing of our water outlets for lead.

On September 10, 2026, water samples were collected by BOCES and analyzed by Pace Analytical. While the vast majority of water outlets across our campus were below the New York State action level, one fixture registered a lead level above the state-mandated action level.

The affected fixture has been removed from service and clearly marked. It is used only for flushing and is not used for drinking or food preparation. The District is working to install a more effective filter and will keep the fixture out of service until remediation and re-testing confirm that it meets New York State standards.

The affected fixture is located at:

Secondary School Greenhouse II Main Water Line — 14.1 ppb

The local health department has been notified, and the District is implementing a remediation plan.
